Build Your Own Study Guide

Instead of providing you with questions to answer for chapters seven and eight, you will be creating your own questions for a classmate to answer.

Assignment:

For each chapter, write five different questions pertaining to the text. These questions can address *characters*, *plot*, *theme*, *symbols*, *figurative language* and so on.

Questions Guidelines:

- You should address at least *three* different literary elements for each chapter.
- Three of your questions from each chapter should require textual support (quote).
- Your questions **should not** be able to be answered using 'yes' or 'no'
- Your questions should address significant points within each chapter.
- You must create at least one journal response question for each chapter. The response for this question should require significant thought, evidence from the text, and at least a paragraph in writing.

These questions are due tomorrow, at which point you will exchange questions with a classmate for them to answer.
